## Your department publishes a lot of papers. How do you communicate their quality?

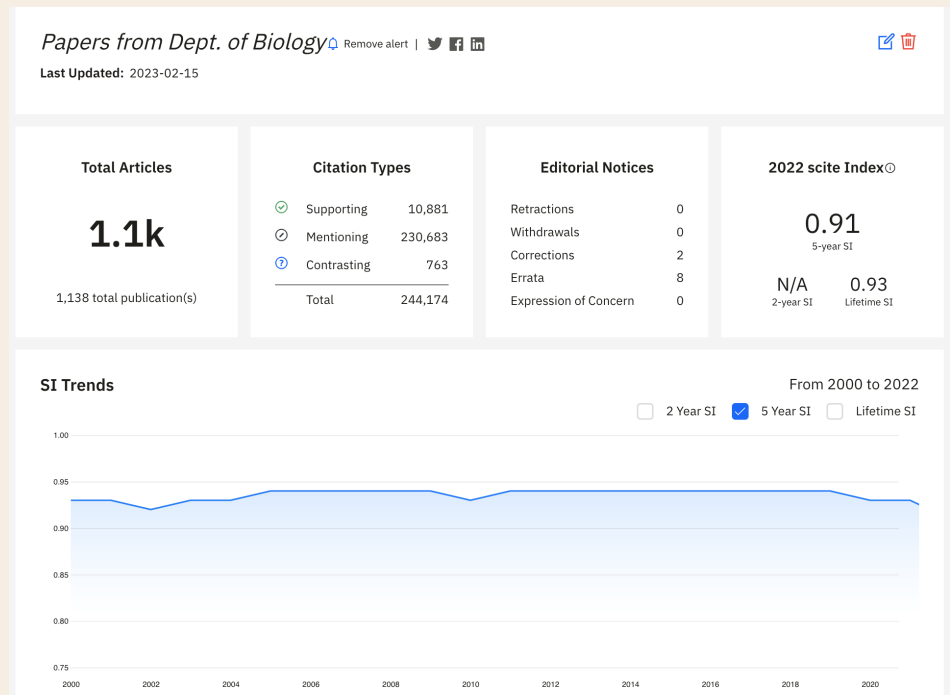
Publication volume and citation counts are often used to describe the effectiveness of research output, but they often leave a lot to be desired. How well supported are findings from a department? Are findings from their research reproducible? Is grant money being used effectively to move the needle on scientific understanding?

## Use dashboards to get aggregate insights about a group of papers to identify, understand, and communicate that nuance.

Use custom dashboards on a list of DOIs you provide and get insights about their performance as a group.

How many supporting statements have they received? What's the trend in the relative amount of support those papers have?
