– Focuses on and provides leadership for educational programs designed to assist seminarians, faculty, employees and monks in research and access to print and electronic resources.

– Works with the Technical Services Librarian to successfully achieve the migration of electronic records and catalog to the new FOLIO system and assist with ongoing training of team and patrons.

Assists with supervision of the Academic Leaders,
a peer-tutoring service promoted by the Academic
Dean and available to seminarians in the library.

 In our small library environment, helps with daily services to patrons in many dimensions of library services.
